

Welcome to our "Moosenbeary" series!

We offer you 3 patterns to make as standalone wall hangings OR combine them as shown here. Combined size - 31"w x 34"h.

Supplies and Directions for combining
Backing 35"w x 38"h
Batting 35"w x 38"h
Sleeve 31" x 3-1/2"
Outside Borders (White or light "wood" print) cut four - 3" wide by WOF
Inside Borders (Dark Brown) cut five - 1" wide by WOF
Flanged Binding
From white or "wood" print - cut four - 1-1/4"w by WOF
From dark brown - cut four - 1-1/2"w by WOF

Background - cut the following pieces and sew together as shown in diagram. Use quarter inch seams, press seams open. - NOTE: Diagram NOT to scale!

Top Sky -	25-1/2"w	by	6"h
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Tan Board - 25-1/2"w by 4"h

Dark Brown - 25-1/2" x 1"

Middle Sky - 25-1/2"w by 5"h

Lake Water 25-1/2"w by 15"h

After making the Background - Layer it (sandwich it). Stitch "in-the-ditch" between the five background sections.

Follow directions in the three patterns for making and adding the appliqué. Do not add the moose in the top section until borders are in place.

Add Borders - quilt any open areas (sky, water, borders).

NOW add moose in top section.

Trim backing & batting even with quilt top.

Make and add a hanging sleeve, a label, and finally make and add the two color flange binding. See directions inside any of the three patterns for "how-to" directions.
